



Court Booking Procedure

When booking a court, you must accept the following Terms and Conditions:

- ❖ neither you or your opponent or anyone in your respective households has had symptoms of Covid-19 in the last two weeks.
- ❖ you and your opponent acknowledge that you play at our own risk and that the club has made every effort to implement the Government and England Squash guidelines.
- ❖ you and your opponent have read and will abide by the HGSRC re-opening rules Squash Bubble rules and Court Booking Procedure.
- ❖ you will cancel the court if, after booking the court, and before the date/time of the court booking, you or someone in your household or your opponent's household shows signs of Covid-19.
- ❖ you and your opponent will respect the facilities and fellow members by following the government guidelines and all HGSRC Rules, Policies and Procedures and you understand failure to do so could result in a club disciplinary.

Please note, the booker will pay the full court cost.

Guests are welcome and their name and contact number must be entered as the opponent in the booking system. The standard £3 guest fee will apply.

There are five permitted ways to play:

1) Members from the same household/support bubble (as defined by the government)

- ❖ Match Play/Full game of squash/racketball allowed
- ❖ You book a court as you normally would by selecting your opponent from the list of members

2) Squash Bubbles

- ❖ You may form a squash bubble with up to five other players and this will allow you to play a full-court match subject to some modifications and additional hygiene measures (see HGSRC Squash Bubble Rules for details)

3) Solo Practice

- ❖ You book a court and select "Solo Practice" as your opponent

4) Two members from different households (if not in a support bubble or squash bubble)

- ❖ You can play a modified version of squash/racketball, called Sides
- ❖ You book a court as you normally would by selecting your opponent from the list of members

5) Coaching

- ❖ You can have 1 to 1 coaching OR
- ❖ You can have coaching with the coach off the court and two players from the same household on court
- ❖ For 1 to 1 coaching select the coach as your opponent
